Subscription:

The ordinary subscription is 1.3% of your gross wages, or a maximum of NOK 630 per month*. There is also an additional mandatory legal insurance premium of NOK 62 per month. For all the details, visit our website at industrienergi.no

Union subscription tax deduction:

In the last two years, the union subscription tax deduction has more than doubled. This means that up to NOK 8,000 of your dues are tax deductible. For an employee on an average industrial worker's wages this may amount to as much as NOK 2,080 less in tax.
